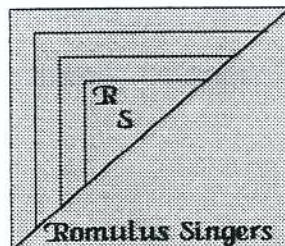


# Music for a Summer's Evening
